## GED testing on computer ...

The GED test is entirely **computer-based testing**, allowing test-takers to demonstrate that they have the basic digital literacy skills that employers, colleges, and researchers say are essential to succeed in today's workplace and career training programs. Testing on computer also means increased scheduling flexibility **for** test-takers. We've been offering the GED test on computer across the U.S. for nearly two years, and the results have been overwhelmingly positive. For instance:

- More than 200,000 GED tests have been taken on computer
- People aren't just passing the test on computers—they're **passing at a rate nearly 15 percentage points higher** than those who take paper-based tests
- People who fail a GED test on computer are nearly **60 percent more likely to re-take the test** than those who take the test on paper
- People taking the GED test on computer **finish faster** than those who take the test on paper, and adults of all ages have described the experience as being "**simple,**" "**less stressful,**" and "**easier**".

### When do I receive my scores?

Same-day access to test scores – you will know right away if you passed and won't have to wait weeks to start applying for jobs, for college or to retake the test.

### Will passing the GED® tests get me into college?

Roughly 98 percent of U.S. colleges and universities accept GED® graduates in the same manner as high school graduates. Be sure to check with the institution in which you are applying to see if they accept GED® graduates. After earning your GED® credential, sign up to take the ACT and/or the SAT. The colleges to which you apply may also require you to take placement or achievement tests so that they can determine whether you need additional coursework.
