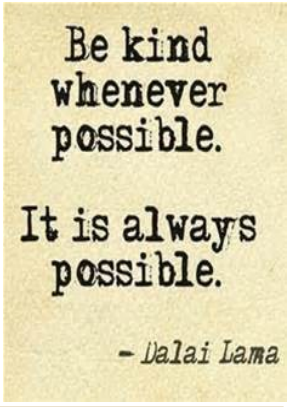
We look forward to a great 2022-2023 school year at the Family Service Center!
